Judges' Observations/ Suggestions

- ❖ Courthouse always needs a map with their supplies
- ❖ Post signs on polling places not being used which direct voters to correct poll
- ❖ Feedback to workers would be good (how did they do on provisional ballots, etc.)
- ❖ Training class 101 for brand new workers
- ❖ Checklist for equipment/ supplies checkout
- ❖ Revise Chain of Custody - who signs where and when
- ❖ When using ePollbook, educate voters via newspaper on bar code scanning (cert.)
- ❖ ePollbook security - will paper list still be necessary?
