Burnet County Commissioners Invite Public to Jail Meeting

BURNET, TEXAS--The Burnet County Commissioners Court today called a public meeting to address issues regarding the expansion of the Burnet County jail facility. The meeting will be held on Monday, November 19, at 7:00 PM in the main courtroom of the Burnet County Courthouse.

“We understand that there are many questions about the jail facility, and will continue to give weekly updates,” said Bill Neve, Burnet County Commissioner, Precinct 1.

Also attending the meeting will be members of the Burnet County Public Facility Corporation, or PFC. The PFC is a non-profit body created by the Burnet County Commissioners Court to oversee the financing, construction, and operations of the jail facility. In addition to Burnet County Judge Donna Klaeger and Precinct 1 Commissioner Bill Neve, the PFC includes County Sheriff Joe Pollock, County Auditor Kevin Smith, and Billy Don Everett, a public citizen.

The Commissioners Court has invited consultants C3 Corrections and Southwestern Correctional, LLC to also be present to provide information.

“This issue is critical to Burnet County and its residents,” said Judge Klaeger. “All interested citizens are encouraged to attend.”
