Time: The sale of the Property will be held between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. local time; **the earliest time at which the Foreclosure Sale will begin is 10:00 a.m. and not later than three hours thereafter.**

Place: The area on the east side of the Burnet County Courthouse (outside the county clerk’s office), located at 220 South Pierce Street, Burnet, Texas 78611, or in inclement weather, the east hallway

inside the courthouse, outside the doorway to the county clerk's office. If the preceding area is no longer the designated area, the place of sale will be at the area most recently designated by the Commissioners Court of Burnet County, pursuant to §51.002 of the Texas Property Code as the place where foreclosure sales are to take place (if such place is not so designated, the sale will take place in the area where this Notice of Foreclosure Sale is posted), in the City of Burnet, Burnet County, Texas.

Terms of Sale: The Foreclosure Sale will be conducted as a public auction and the Property will be sold to the highest bidder for cash, except that Jay P. Otto's bid may be by credit against the indebtedness secured by the lien of the Deed of Trust.

Default has occurred in the payment of the Note and in the performance of the obligations of the Deed of Trust. Because of that default, Jay P. Otto, the owner and holder of the Note, has requested Substitute Trustee to sell the Property.

The Deed of Trust may encumber both real and personal property. Formal notice is hereby given of Jay P. Otto's election to proceed against and sell both the real property and any personal property described in the Deed of Trust in accordance with Jay P. Otto's rights and remedies under the Deed of Trust and section 9.604(a) of the Texas Business and Commerce Code.

Therefore, notice is given that on and at the Date, Time, and Place for the Foreclosure Sale described above, Substitute Trustee will sell the Property in accordance with the Terms of Sale described above, the Deed of Trust, and applicable Texas law.

If Jay P. Otto passes the Foreclosure Sale, notice of the date of any rescheduled foreclosure sale will be reposted and refiled in accordance with the posting and filing requirements of the Deed of Trust and the Texas Property Code.

The Foreclosure Sale will be made expressly subject to any title matters set forth in the Deed of Trust, but prospective bidders are reminded that by law the Foreclosure Sale will necessarily be made subject to all prior matters of record affecting the Property, if any, to the extent that they remain in force and effect and have not been subordinated to the Deed of Trust. For the avoidance of doubt, the Foreclosure Sale will not cover any part of the Property that has been released of public record from the lien and/or security interest of the Deed of Trust by [Lender/Beneficiary]. Prospective bidders are strongly urged to examine the applicable property records to determine the nature and extent of such matters, if any.

Pursuant to section 51.009 of the Texas Property Code, the Property will be sold **"AS IS," without any expressed or implied warranties, except as to the warranties (if any) provided for under the Deed of Trust.** Prospective bidders are advised to conduct an independent investigation of the nature and physical condition of the Property.

Pursuant to section 51.0075(a) of the Texas Property Code, Substitute Trustee reserves the right to set further reasonable conditions for conducting the Foreclosure Sale. Any such

further conditions shall be announced before bidding is opened for the first sale of the day held by Substitute Trustee.
