1. Call Meeting to Order.
2. Public Comment: Members of the public may speak for up to three minutes regarding general topics or specific agenda items. This may not exceed 30 minutes in total unless approved by the Board at the start of the meeting. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General's opinion, any public comment that is made on any item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners.
3. Public Comment on Agenda items: Individual members of the public may address the Board for a maximum of three minutes per person per agenda item. This may not exceed 30 minutes in total unless approved by the board at the start of the meeting. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Members of the public will speak on agenda items before the Board consideration of item. Members of the public who wish to speak on agenda items or make a public comment must complete speaker cards prior to the beginning of the Board meetings.
4. Discuss and consider approval of April 30, 2026 meeting minutes;
5. Discuss and consider action on obtaining Treasurer's bond;
6. Discuss and consider action to adopt a fire code;
7. Discuss and consider action on contracts for administrative services;
8. Discuss and consider action on service provider contract for emergency services;
9. Discuss and consider action regarding schedule for budget and financial planning discussions, including discussions with service provider regarding short and long term needs;
10. Discuss and consider action regarding policies needed by District for ongoing management and operations;
11. Discuss and consider action regarding District website and emails;
12. Discuss and consider action to approve a Resolution Designating Signatory Authority;
13. Discuss and consider action regarding obtaining sales tax exemption from Comptroller's Office;
14. Discuss and consider action on authorizing filing report with the Texas Division of Emergency Management; and
15. Adjournment.
