



DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER IN BURNET COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Burnet beginning on the 4th day of July, 2025 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from excessive multiple rounds of rainfall;

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Burnet has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property and infrastructure;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 418.108 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, BY THE BURNET COUNTY JUDGE:



1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Burnet.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Burnet County commissioners court.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Burnet County emergency management plan.
