

## EXTENSION OF A DECLARED LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER IN BURNET COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Burnet beginning on the 4th day of July, 2025 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, and loss of life and property resulting from excessive multiple rounds of rainfall;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of the County of Burnet has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property and infrastructure;

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Burnet declared a local state of disaster on August 5, 2025 pursuant to 418.108 (a) Texas Government Code.

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Burnet declared a local state of disaster on September 2, 2025 pursuant to 418.108 (a) Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 418.108 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, BY THE BURNET COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT:

- 1. That a state of disaster is declared and continued for the County of Burnet until October 2, 2025.
- 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the local state of disaster is continued and renewed by the Burnet County commissioners court and shall continue for a period of not more than thirty days after the declaration by the County Judge.
- 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- 4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Burnet County emergency management plan.
