The District may meet in executive session on any item listed above as provided by the Open Meetings Act, Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 551.071, 551.072, 551.073, 551.074, or 551.075.

The Board does not have a meeting place within the boundaries of the District, but instead meets regularly at (1) Lloyd Gosselink Rochelle & Townsend, P.C., 816 Congress Avenue, Suite 1900, Austin, Texas 78701; (2) Horseshoe Bay Resort Marriott, 200 Hi Circle North, Horseshoe Bay, Texas 78657; or (3) Opie's Barbeque, 9504 Highway 71 East, Spicewood, Texas 78669. However, pursuant to Texas Water Code § 49.062(c), on written request of a minimum of five qualified electors (but only if at least 25 qualified electors reside in the District), the Board shall designate a meeting place located within the District upon a finding that the meeting place used by the District deprives its residents of a reasonable opportunity to attend District meetings. Should the Board fail to designate the location of the meeting place within the District, five electors may petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to designate a location inside or outside the District, which is reasonably available to the public, and require that the meetings be held at such a place.
