Thank you to everyone who contributed to our successful Amplify fundraiser.

We truly appreciate your generosity. The approximately \$13,000 raised has made a meaningful impact. That said, we still have about \$800,000 to go to meet our total project goal of \$2 million. We're excited to share that Phase 1-A, which includes site preparation and slab pouring, is set to begin in April. This will be followed by Phase 1-B, the installation of the steel framing.

Our next fundraiser will be a Mah Jongg Tournament hosted at Quail Point Lodge in Horseshoe Bay on May 5th. More information can be found further down in this newsletter.

Our story time friends will have to press pause for a week. Tiny Tykes is taking a short break on April 7th.

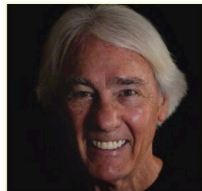
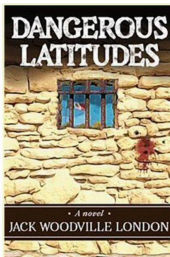

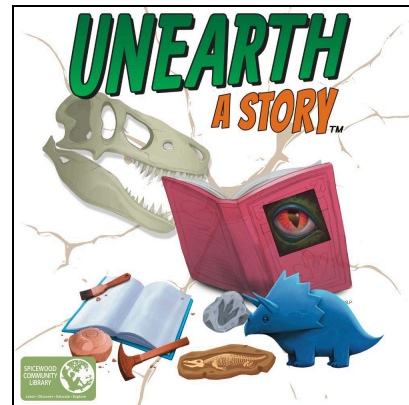
## Community Shred Day
