

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I get a library card?

- Visit our catalog at <https://catalog.burnetcountylibrary.org/catalog/> and click the sign up button in the top right corner. After completing the sign up form you will need to come into the library with a valid photo ID.

How much does a library card cost?

- NOTHING! Library cards are free.

Can my child get a library card?

- Yes- as long as an adult household member has a valid library card.

Will my card from another Burnet County Library work here?

- Yes- any valid card from a Burnet County Library will work at our library.

What is my pin or password?

- A pin number is the same as a password. If you can not remember the password you selected when you signed up, first try your phone number. If you continue to have problems call the library.

How long can items be checked out?

- Items are checked out for 2 weeks. Items without reserves will auto-renew for an additional 2 weeks.

Can I return items to different branches?

- Yes- you can return items from our library at any Burnet County Library.

Do I have to have a library card to use the library?

- NO! we'd love to have you visit the library anytime.

Do you offer computer services?

- Yes- we offer patron computers, printer services, copies, and faxing. Any copies/prints are 10 cents for black & white and 50 cents for color.

Do you have a notary?

- Yes, we offer notary service. Spicewood Community Library notaries DO NOT notarize wills. Please call the library before arriving to verify a notary is available.
