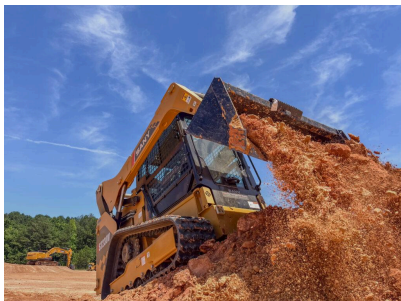


Welcome to the library

CONSTRUCTION HAS BEGUN!

The earth movers have moved in, and we are excited to announce that site work has begun for the new library building! Phase 1A includes site prep, power, plumbing, and other underground infrastructure, culminating with the slab pour. Fundraising continues to fully support Phase 1B which includes erecting the building structure, exterior walls, doors, windows, and roofing. The board is seeking grants, sponsorships, pledges, and donations at any level.

Please remember that due to construction, parking may be limited at times.

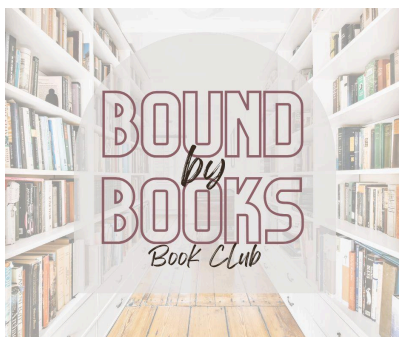
The library will be closed on July 4th.
