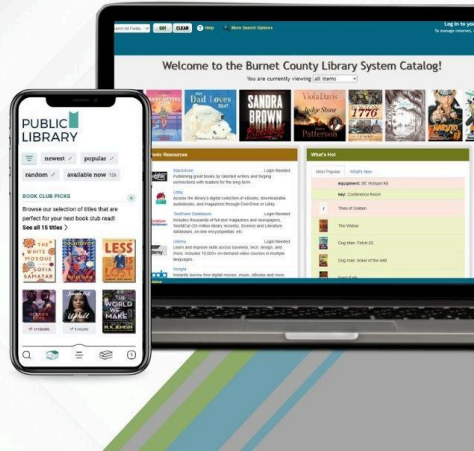

Calling all Mah Jongg enthusiasts!

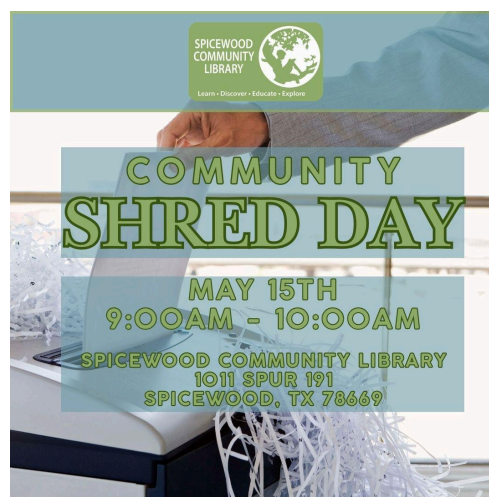
Get ready for a day of fun and strategy at The Friends of Spicewood Community Library's Mah Jongg Tournament on May 5th.

But don't worry, the fun returns September 8th, ready for more stories, songs, and smiles.

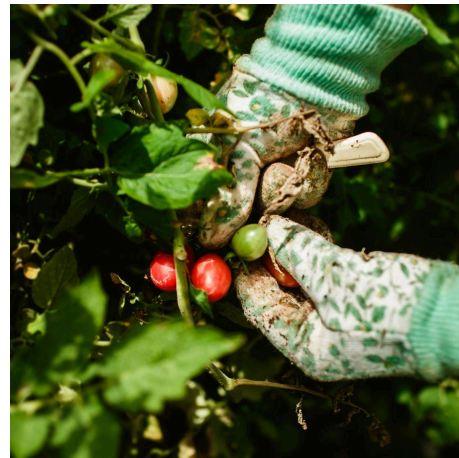
Bound By Books book club
