- 2. Chief Curtis reported that CVFD had received an application/resume received from a Medic out of Williamson County in hopes of a volunteer position being available.
- 3. Currently, there are no training events to report.
- 4. Chief Curtis reported that CVFD are planning to participate in the community parade in Cassie and Buena Vista subdivisions. He also reported that they had participated in "Welcome Back to Summer" at the Community Center and will continue to do so in the future activities.

10. (AI) Administrative update of the Sales Tax Program for Burnet County ESD No 2 including update reports for HdL – Strategic Plan #5 Goal (Proffer)

(AD) Commissioner Barclay noted that the May Sales Tax received is \$8413.00 which is a YoY 14.2% decrease. (Enclosure 5)

11. (AI) Joint task Force Report – Strategic Plan #5 Goal 1. (Barclay/Proffer/Curtis/Schoenfeld)

(AD) Commissioner Barclay and Chief Curtis met in May to review Strategic Planning #5 Goal #1. Chief Curtis stated the Fire Code books arrived and are available if anyone needs to review. He also noted that he will hold off on the website subscription regarding Fire Code payments.

12. (AI) Discussion and/or action to review and make changes to the Strategic Plan from 2025.

(AD) 1. Strategic Planning #3: -Structures — Chief Curtis Chief Curtis noted that there is no additional space available for more trucks. He suggested that expanding the existing building could be a financially viable solution to address this issue. He also mentioned bay doors will need to move out 6' to accommodate a new vehicle.

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- 2. Strategic Planning Topic #2 -Equipment Chief Curtis stated that Goal #1 is complete. Engine 1 was sold. Goal #2 is pending until Fall 2025 to replace Brush Truck #3.
- 3. Strategic Planning Topic #3 -Staffing Goal#3 Commissioner Barclay noted that there is still money marked for a retention bonus to Volunteers; payable to Volunteers in September 2025 based on longevity.

Strategic Planning Topic #3 Goal #4 -Pension & Retirement – Chief Curtis stated that he is researching all Volunteer Retirement Fund options; also this can be a budget item but are payable from BCESD #2.

- 4. Strategic Planning Topic #4 Training Chief Curtis stated that this is all in progress.
- 5. Strategic Planning Topic #5 -Leadership still meeting on a regular basis. Goal #2 and Goal #3 are in progress. Goal #4 Commissioner Proffer is working on grants. Goal #5 5-year focused budget Goal #6 ongoing Goal #7 in progress
- 6. Strategic Planning Topic #6- Fire Prevention/Education/Pre-Fire Plans- Goal #1 is completed; Goal #2-911 address signs are in progress and available for anyone that still needs one. Goal #4 Commissioner Proffer is the LCRA liaison.

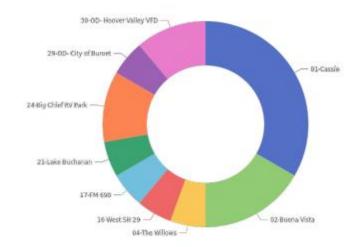

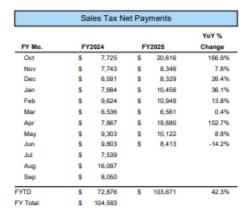
