(AD) Commissioner Barlcay called for corrections to the April 18, 2024, Meeting Minutes: Changes were made to reflect \$9,351.00 in the operating account. No further changes were to be made. Minutes are accepted with corrections.

Commissioner Lee noted that the only thing she transferred was the excess Sales Tax Funds to the Texas Class account.

Commissioner Barclay called for any questions or comments to the Treasurer's Report; with no further discussion, the Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented (Enclosure 2)

#### 9. (AI) Discussion and/or action regarding the disbursement of funds

(AD) Commissioner Lee reported a payment has been made to Mrs. Paz for April. Commissioner Barclay also noted that a bill was received from Attorney on file, but it is not correct. She will work to get the corrected itemized statement and submit for payment.

#### 10. (AI) Discussion and/or action regarding distribution of funds with Texas Class.

(AD) Commissioner Lee discussed the Texas Class accounts. She discussed the differences in the government accounts and commercial accounts. The government accounts earn substantially less interest than the commercial accounts. Both accounts provide protection of the invested funds and can be moved as needed.

Commissioner Lee made a motion to move the monies from Texas Class out of the government account to the commercial account. Commissioner Cheatham made motion to 2nd.

Commissioner Barclay called for discussion; no further discussion was presented. The motion passed unanimously.

- (AD) Chief Curtis gave the report on the CVFD activity for the month of April 2024.

  CFVFD responded to 21 calls 15 EMS / 6 Fire/Other. Mutual Aid 4 given; none received. There were no overlapping calls. Average response time for April was 8:31 minutes. In-District calls 7:32; M-F 9-5 6:27; Out of District 12:29. The average personnel per call for April was 5.6. (Enclosure 3)
  - B. Mrs. Schneider provided the CVFD Treasurers Report for April 2024. There was a balance of \$ 55,300.36 in Checking. Expenses for April were \$26,485.26, including expenses for routine operations and training and Eclipse related expenses. Mrs. Schneider provided the CVFD Operations Report –Total YTD Expenses \$142,306.97.

Mrs. Schneider provided the CVFD Account Report- current balance is \$117,497.83 with no activity for April. (Enclosure 4)

Commissioner Barclay asked for an estimate of expenses of Eclipse and Mrs. Schneider gave approximate amount of \$2,500.00.

(AD) Commissioner Barclay stated for the month of May we will receive \$9303.00 which is a -10.3 YoY change. She reported that there was a large decrease in retail sales and manufacturing; she will continue to monitor this information. (Enclosure 5)

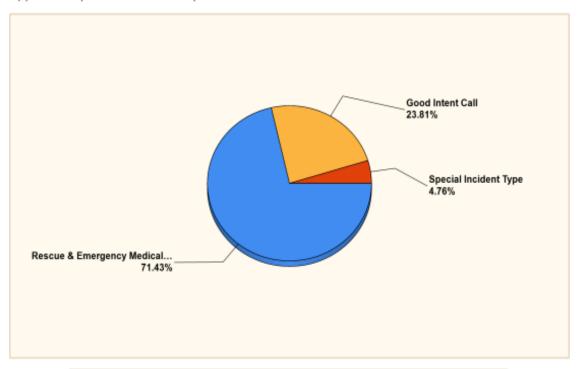

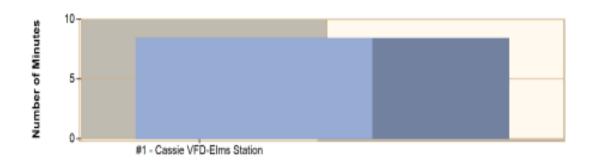

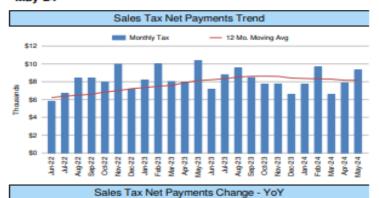

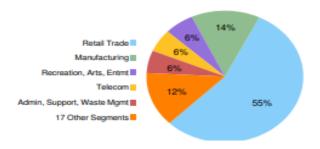
